He said the cold + cough was all + gave her some cough medicine which acted wonderfully for her, in a few days she was not coughing any + ever since has seemed better as she does not all clear up her throat + spit of a morning like she did before. She sleeps well + is as happy as a child can be. She talks about you every day + asks + asks + asks again what we think papa + mamma are doing. It puzzles her to hear that Gladys can talk she cannot understand it. She is as bad about me learning her as she was about her mother last summer. Almost, some times cries after me. I went to a lecture one night this week + she called me back the third time to kiss her good night + wanted + I gave her five dolls + when I came back this morn

l on the pillow close to her.

Miss's has sold her home & are building on the
west side in across & a little north of the
winds church, a two story square.

My + Paul seem to be getting along quite well
are to have a birthday dinner or supper rather
worn evening here. as father + Pauline's birthdays
to come in sabbath & we did not want to have it
sabbath. I wish I had strength to make a long
trip but I do not. It is grandma, grandma, grandma
6 in the morning till 7 at night.

was at the Miss Board meeting fourth day
this week. Leggie Monie Gooden + husband are to come
Alaska this coming year possibly. Charles Repley +
son + maybe others. Vanain stayed with Father
was watching for me + came learning up the street
she saw me coming home from the car.

stayed one or the other of us at home most all the
time and kept Vanain very close while the diphtheria
in town did not let her go to S.S. or hardly out on
street. Eltie Proude's little girl died only weeks a
few days. their only child, just Vanain's age.

there were only two or three cases + it has been weeks now
since there was any. must close
Vanain sends pictures to Gladys.
