

Deering, Alaska

Feb 25, 1948

My dear sister in Christ Mrs. Anna H. F. Marshall,

We have received your letter sometime ago, and have read it Church, so I ask how many know you or remember, so 11 of us raise hands. And so glad to hear from because we know you, and never hear from you so long, and when you try to preach to them 9 years before 1909 only 2 remembers. One is Mary Morris and Poots Vestal.

I think you have forgotten me, you are the one I interpret at candle when you preach the Gospel, spring of 1909, March. For the first time I try interpret. I was fifteen then, you remember. My father and I went to Selawik and on the way going home to Unalakleet. We stay about a week. While staying I use to play at your house and help little house work with Ashugak, ever since Ashugak & I been together as real sisters. I think you hear she has gone home to with Jesus Christ whom she loved until her last breath. Praise the Lord for another world where we will never part again.

Hope you enjoy this letter and try write again, seems like you & Carrie are our Mothers in Jesus. We understand its not little thing come where is no people preaching. I am willing or very glad to say for myself to that I never stop telling about my precious Saviour [sic] Jesus Christ since then.
